Packets for Monday evening's Council Meeting were delivered on Thursday. The Packet is online at [Packets - 2018](#) for the Monday, September 17<sup>th</sup> evening council meeting.

The Public Works Crew has been busy constructing two fishing docks at the Pond. They have started on a walking trail that will go around the Pond. We still have the Pond closed.

Tis the season to have waterline breaks and there have been several this past week. The most troublesome was at the intersection of Schley and Grant. The crew worked on several more including on the springs line between Rock Creek Road and the plant. On Wednesday they replaced parts of two pressure relief valves on the spring line above Rock Creek Road. They also cleaned the grate across the northern terminus of the pavement on NW Viola.

County Emergency Management will have their annual winter planning meeting on October 11<sup>th</sup>.

This week, Oregon Association of Water Utilities (OAWU) surveyed the depth of the water in the sewer lagoons. From this they can estimate the build-up of solids on the bottom of the lagoons. This is important for efficient processing and determining if we need to remove the bottom sludge.

The Seed to Supper Class did not have enough registrants. It has been delayed and the Park & Recreation Committee is seeking more students. It is tentatively scheduled to run each Saturday for two hours starting on September 29<sup>th</sup> and running through November 3<sup>rd</sup>.
