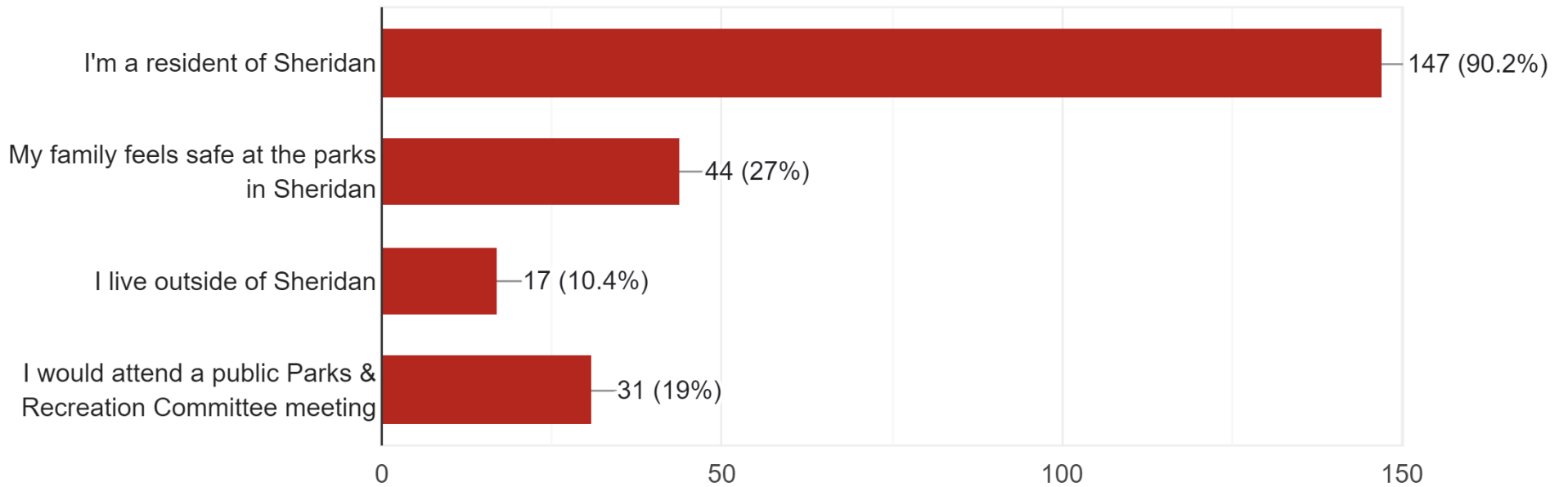

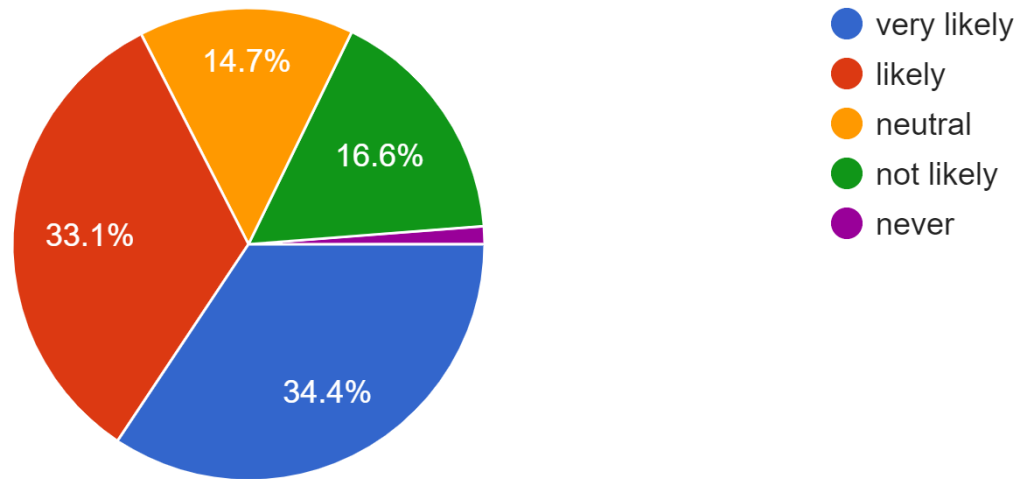

How likely is your family to visit the parks in Sheridan?

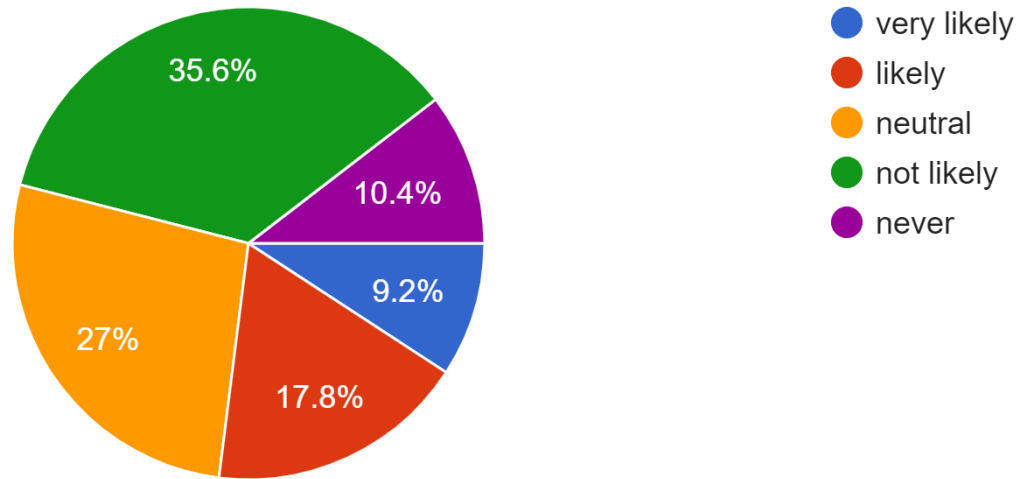

How likely are you to host a gathering at the parks in Sheridan?

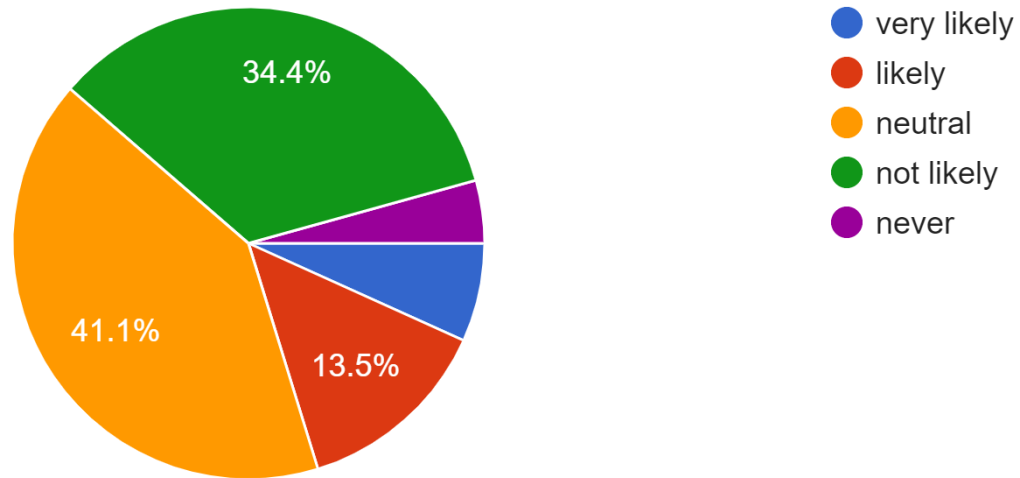

How likely are you to volunteer at the parks?

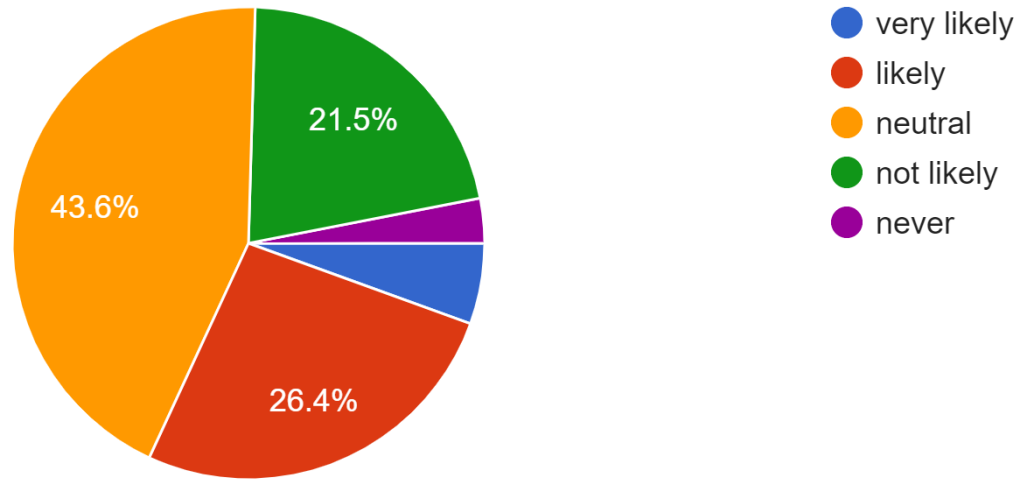

How satisfied is your family with the playground facilities at the parks in Sheridan?

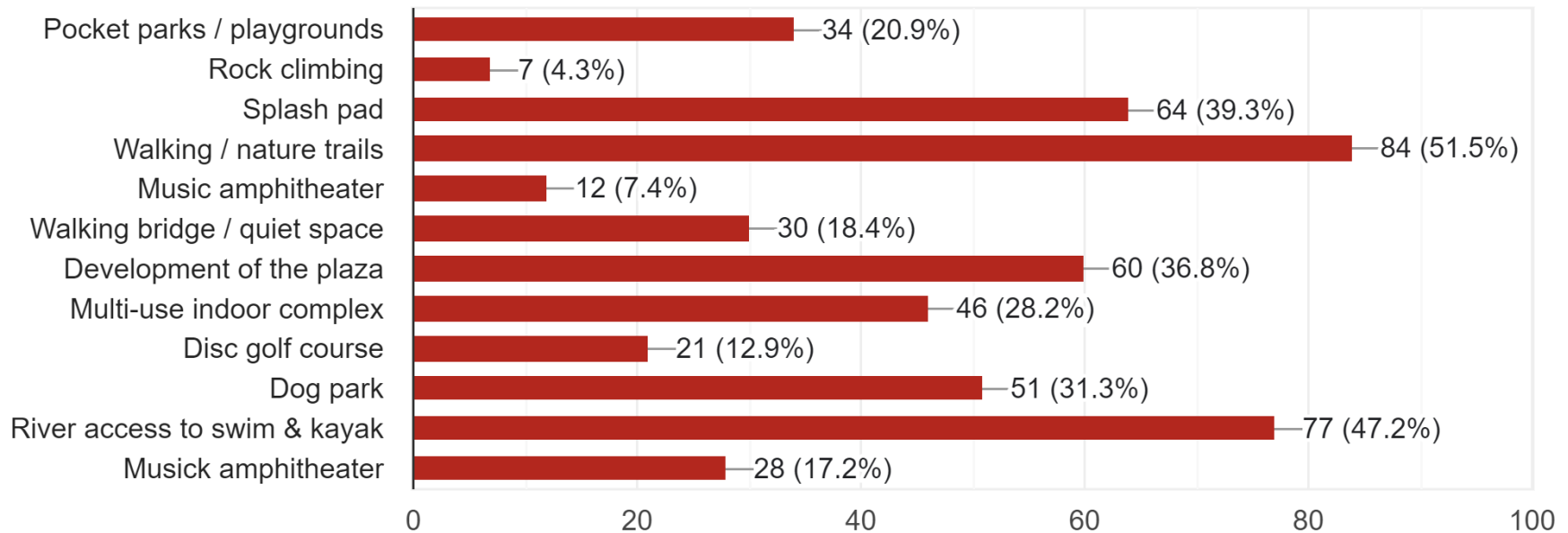

The following are comments taken from the P&R Questionnaire

Comments/Suggestions

I firmly believe there needs to be more parks in Sheridan. Kids need places to play that are accessible by walking. Small pocket parks throughout the city will improve quality of life, health, property values. In our neighborhood all the kids play in the street. But there is an empty lot right there that if mowed with a swing set would be used daily!

It also makes sense that we take advantage of the river! Let people use it!

I think indoor facility would be great! But would need to be very thoughtful so that it could be successful/feasible. I don't think it would need to be too big for it to be well utilized and valuable for the community. I would LOVE to see more cooperation between the city and the school district- maybe a shared agreement could be reached so community members could use gyms and playgrounds at times the school wasn't using them.

Small towns can't copy what larger cities do. We need to cooperate and get creative and we can make a wonderful place to live and raise kids!

Hard to select just 3 on above question, I also want an Amphitheater, walking bridge, dog park. river access ...etc but my REAL #1 would be a path for walking/biking ALL along our river from Sheridan to Willamina.

When I took my family to Salem waterfront team it was nice to see that they have a crew of cleaners who go around keep bathrooms cleaned, garbage cans emptied, and debris cleaned up all day. I know it would cost to employ these workers but it would be a way to enforce and maintain the park clean. We came from Washington county and we fell in love with Sheridan. I'm just not really liking taking my kids to the park. It's a little shady.

What keeps my family away from Sheridan City Park are the disrespectful youth that hang out there, and stray dogs that may or may not be friendly to my children. I do not feel safe there. We would love to have a way to access the river without climbing down a steep embankment. We would also enjoy an indoor place to play when the weather isn't cooperative.

Asphalt the "grassy" area that faces the ball field on Yamhill St. The sign says "don't park on grass"!! Make it a parking area so parents can watch their kids games in inclement weather!!! Will save hourly upkeep of the grass too!!!

We love the parks. The graffiti at the main park has been really discouraging. I thought cameras were supposed to be installed. ?

Thanks for doing this! I think our town needs opportunities for rest. Rockclimbing, music amphitheater, etc are great ideas but a later priority imo.

Better bathroom facilities at the parks. The Porta potties are generally disgusting and it's hard to take children to play and then pack up and find a bathroom.

Maybe a Bike Park, or place to ride bikes, pump track. Help clean up the skate park area and add a bike section

Park patrols, Safety, enforcement, cameras

Cooperate with the school district to open up district fields and playgrounds for public use when school is not in session.

How about a safe way to walk to the park by the prison from town?

Rock climbing would be awesome, as it's a favorite hobby of mine, but I'm not sure how practical that is.

An indoor or covered sports area for other than basketball would be nice. My daughter started volleyball this year, and there was no real place to practice without major interruption

City access to the beautiful Yamhill river is my number one choice.

Playground equipment at the city park is damaged and could use more wood chips. I understand why there are no accessible bathrooms in the park but there has to be some solution to keep the restroom functional and accessible.

We tend to avoid the city park unless it's busy. I feel safest at the pond. The parks themselves are fine and my kids enjoy the play structures. I don't trust the crowds that hang out when it's quiet. I will absolutely never let my kids go to any parks without me. Mostly my issues are visitors like the homeless, drug users and unchecked older kids/teens


Open the bathrooms!!

Create something for bikes and not that lost skatepark trails, jumps, a trading ground for skills on the bike

Amphitheater would give the kids and families something to look forward to. Plays, dance performers, music, but make it affordable so people will actually book in a small town with a smaller audience.
